

# Insurance Discounts Available for Policy Year 2021-2022

Listed below are the insurance discounts, available to ICRMP members, that will apply to the premium for the policy year starting October 1, 2021. Each discount has an individual percentage amount applied that will add up to your final cumulative discount based on what you complete. Any discounts achieved will be applied to your premium calculation estimate that is delivered to you by May 1, 2021. Be sure to get items completed before that date.

## Law Enforcement Discounts

- Detention/Jail Assessment – 1% discount
- Patrol Assessment – 1% discount
- Emergency Vehicle Operations Course – 1% discount
- Use of Force Course – 1% discount

## Cyber Liability Discount

- KnowBe4 (or similar) participation – 1% discount

## Human Resources Discount

- Human Resources Assessment – 1% discount

You can use our portal to have your employees acknowledge and sign your individual policies. # Law Enforcement Discounts

To schedule your law enforcement assessments or to determine what qualifies for proof of courses, contact ICRMP's Law Enforcement Risk Manager, Chad Sarmento, at (208) 246-8203 or [csarmento@icrmp.org](mailto:csarmento@icrmp.org).

- **Detention/Jail Assessment** – The assessment is an online and in-person assessment of your detention operations. To receive access to, or schedule a visit for a detention assessment, contact Chad Sarmento. Completion of the jail assessment will earn a 1% discount.
  
- **Patrol Assessment** – The assessment is open to all counties and cities with patrol operations. The assessment is an online and in-person assessment of your patrol operations. To receive access to, or schedule a visit for a patrol assessment, contact Chad Sarmento. Completion of the patrol assessment will earn a 1% discount.
  
- **Qualifying Emergency Vehicle Operations Course** – For counties and cities that have law enforcement, a 1% discount is achieved when you provide Chad Sarmento proof of Emergency Vehicle Operations Course.
  
- **Qualifying Use of Force Course** – For counties and cities that have law enforcement, a 1% discount is achieved when you provide Chad Sarmento proof of Use of Force Course.

# Cyber Liability Discount

- **KnowBe4 Participation** – A 1% discount will be given to organizations who participate in KnowBe4 or a similar cyber awareness training and phishing testing program. This discount is available to all ICRMP public entity members. To achieve the discount, your organization's click rate on phishing tests needs to be at 5% or less on April 15, 2021 (in KnowBe4, this click rate is called "Phish Prone").

If you do not have KnowBe4 or a similar program, contact Justin for more information on how to join. ICRMP provides KnowBe4 subscriptions to members at no additional cost to you. To participate, you must have your own email domain, and not use a free email service such as Gmail, Hotmail, AOL, etc.

If you have a program different from KnowBe4, you must meet the following requirements to achieve the discount:

- At-least monthly education or training sent to all users
- At-least monthly phishing email tests sent to all users

# Human Resources Discount

- **Human Resources Assessment** – A 1% discount will be given for those organizations who complete the human resources assessment. This requirement is open to all ICRMP public entity members. The survey is a self-assessment of your human resources processes and should take less than 2 hours to complete. This assessment will include specific questions about your employee population, including classifications, training, and require upload of your HR policies and documents. This survey should be completed by the person with the most knowledge of these topics.
