
ADVANCED REPORT WRITING FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT

This course is open to all sworn Detention and Patrol staff.

Presented through a combination of classroom lecture and practical exercises, this 4-hour course will provide students with an advanced review of report fundamentals for both proper documentation of officer activities and when submissions are needed for court proceedings. This presentation includes what to document in the event of a jail death, high-risk use of force and documentation needed should a case be brought against an agency in Federal Court. Topics covered will include:
