

INMATE GRIEVANCES YOUR LEGAL RESPONSIBILITIES

This course is open to all sworn or non-sworn Detention Center staff, medical first responders, or related public service agency personnel.

Presented through a combination of classroom lecture and class exercises, this 2-hour course will provide students with materials that will help them understand the importance of inmate grievances and the Federal and State Laws that govern them. Legal requirements regarding inmate rights will be discussed with an emphasis on the 1st, 4th, 5th, 6th, 8th, and 14th Amendments. Topics covered will include:

Due Processes w/Grievances	Rights guaranteed
8th Amendment guarantees	Federal Laws
State Laws	Deputy applications
