

ARCON: BASIC TAKEDOWN, RESTRAINTS AND SEARCHING

This course is open to all sworn Patrol and Detention personnel for both Sheriff's Offices and Police Department personnel.

Attendees can expect a hands-on learning environment to include discussion and training where application of laws will be attached directly to real life use of force training. Current case laws will be reviewed, with each discipline instructed.
